

GENERAL INFORMATION

MISSOURI STATE SPECIFIC LAND SURVEYING EXAMINATION

NCEES Exam Administration Services will administer the Missouri Specific Land Surveying examination on behalf of the Missouri Board.

Upon notification that your application has been approved by the Missouri Board, it will be necessary for you to complete the final scheduling of the examination with NCEES by accessing their web site www.ncees.org completing the registration form and remitting the required book, scoring and administration fee.

LAND SURVEYOR MISSOURI SPECIFIC EXAMINATION

Effective with the April 12, 2013 exam administration the Missouri state-specific land surveyor exam will be split into two parts. Passing both parts of the Missouri state-specific examination (as well as passing the required NCEES Fundamentals of Surveying examination and the Principles and Practice of Surveying examination) will be required to become licensed as a Professional Land Surveyor in Missouri.

Part I and Part II of the Missouri state-specific exam will each be a separate one-hour exam. Both parts of the exam will remain open-book.

You must pass both parts of the Missouri state-specific examination. You may register for one or both parts of an exam administration.
