Upon discussion, Mr. Govero made a motion directing Ms. Kempker to send a letter to Mr. Pulliam advising that the Professional Land Surveying Division Members highly recommend that a licensed Professional Land Surveyor teach surveying courses but it is noted that Chapter 327 does not require a licensed Professional Land Surveyor teach the surveying courses. The motion was seconded by Mr. Flowers. A roll call vote was taken and unanimously carried.
