ORDER SUSPENDING PROFESSIONAL LICENSE

On this 9th day of July, 2012, Petitioner

appeared by and through its attorney of record, Assistant Attorney General, Sara E. Reeb. Respondent, Laron Whalen [appeared in person, appeared by attorney (failed to appear)]. Based upon the verified petition, evidence adduced and the record as a whole, this Court makes the following findings:

1. This Court has subject matter jurisdiction over this suit and personal jurisdiction over the parties.
2. Respondent was served with the Petition to Suspend Professional License and Notice of Intent to Suspend Professional License (Notice of Intent) personally on September 29, 2011.
3. The Notice of Intent stated that Respondent's barber license number 2008032283 shall be suspended within sixty (60) days of service of

the Notice of Intent unless Respondent: (1) paid the entire arrearage stated in the Notice of Intent; or (2) entered into and complied with a payment plan approved by this Court; or (3) requested a hearing before this Court.

4. As of the date Respondent was served with the Notice of Intent, the Respondent owed a child support arrearage that was at least three months of support payments or \$2500, whichever is less.

5. Respondent has failed to pay the entire arrearage stated in the Notice of Intent.

6. Respondent has failed to enter into and comply with a payment plan approved by this Court.

7. Respondent has failed to request a hearing, within sixty (60) days of being served with the Notice of Intent, to show cause why Respondent's barber license should not be suspended.

[REDACTED] Respondent has a barber license, number 2008032283.

IT IS THEREFORE ORDERED, ADJUDGED AND DECREED that Respondent's barber license, License Number 2008032283 is suspended. Respondent shall refrain from engaging in this licensed activity.

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED, ADJUDGED AND DECREED that Missouri Division of Professional Registration located at 3605 Missouri

Boulevard, P.O. Box 1335, Jefferson City, MO 65102-1335 shall, upon receipt of this order:

1. Determine if the licensing authority has issued a license to the Respondent;
2. Enter the suspension of Respondent's license as effective from the date of this Order Suspending License;
3. Issue a Notice of Suspension to Respondent; and
4. If required by law, demand surrender of the suspended license.

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED, ADJUDGED AND DECREED that the Missouri Division of Professional Registration shall process this order without conducting an additional hearing or review.

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED, ADJUDGED AND DECREED that this Court's order suspending Respondent's license shall be implemented by the Missouri Division of Professional Registration and shall continue until the Missouri Division of Professional Registration receives notice from this Court that this suspension has been stayed or terminated.

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED, ADJUDGED AND DECREED that any funds paid by the Respondent to the Missouri Division of Professional Registration for costs related to issuance, renewal or maintenance of a license shall not be refunded to Respondent.

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED, ADJUGED AND DECREED that the Missouri Division of Professional Registration shall not modify, remand, reverse, vacated, or stay this Court's order suspending Respondent's professional license.

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED, ADJUDGED AND DECREED that the costs of this action are taxed against Respondent.
