The telephone conference call meeting of the Missouri Dental Board was called to order by Dr. Eric Aubert, President, at approximately 7:04 p.m. on Wednesday, June 1, 2005. The conference call meeting originated from the Dental Board Office at the Division of Professional Registration, 3605 Missouri Boulevard, Jefferson City, Missouri.

To better track the order in which items were taken up on the agenda, each item in the minutes will be listed in the order it was discussed in the meeting.

APPROVAL OF AGENDA

A motion was made by Dr. Christman and seconded by Ms. Lepp that the agenda be approved as written. Motion carried unanimously.

DENTAL ORGANIZATION FOR CONSCIOUS SEDATION

The Board reviewed the enteral conscious sedation course material presented by the Dental Organization for Conscious Sedation (DOCS). Dr. Deyton commended DOCS for being responsive to his letter outlining the improvements that needed to be made in order for their course to meet the Board's requirements. Dr. Deyton informed the Board that he believes the staff exam on monitoring needs more work, but overall, his recommendation to the Board is to consider approving the DOCS course as meeting the requirements for an enteral conscious sedation permit with a few minor improvements.

Dr. Hoffmann informed the Board that he still has concerns about the program's incremental dosing protocol. The instructors do not all have formal advanced post-doctoral training in pain and anxiety control. He also said that there were several errors made in the presentation of the course. Dr. Hoffmann was concerned that there were no bad outcomes presented during the course, such as over-sedations and failed sedations. They have a lack of understanding of the ASA Classification of ranking patients risk status for anesthesia. He informed the Board that he would like to see a pre-op evaluation of the patient and pre-op mental status in the video presentations. Dr. Hoffmann suggested that the DOCS program include patients with more complex medical histories in their teachings. Dr. Hoffmann also indicated that there needs to be improvement in the airway stations, and that the exam should be more comprehensive. Without these changes, Dr. Hoffmann could not recommend approval of the program as meeting the requirements for an enteral permit under the Board's rule.

Ms. Lola Swaby and Dr. Tony Feck expressed to the Board that they were under the impression that once the DOCS program met the eleven requirements outlined in the letter from Dr. Deyton, that the course would be approved. Dr. Feck and Dr. Silverman thanked Dr. Deyton and Dr. Hoffmann for working with the DOCS program and making recommendations to help improve their program. They also addressed many of their concerns regarding the course.

After further discussion, a motion was made by Dr. Jackson and seconded by Dr. Christman to approve the DOCS' three-day enteral conscious sedation course presented from May 2005 forward to meet the requirements for an applicant to receive an enteral conscious sedation permit, contingent on DOCS augmenting the monitoring exam for staff. Motion carried unanimously. A motion was made by Dr. Sheets and seconded by Dr. McCoy that the DOCS program also be approved to satisfy the requirement for fifteen hours of continuing education pertaining to medical emergencies, anesthesia complications or patient management while under sedation. Motion carried unanimously.

DR. JOHN DANE’S “DENTAL OFFICE EMERGENCIES”

The Board reviewed the material for Dr. John Dane’s “Dental Office Emergencies” course. A motion was made by Dr. Jackson and seconded by Dr. Christman to approve Dr. Dane’s course for three hours of the fifteen hour continuing education requirement pertaining to medical emergencies, anesthesia complications or patient management while under sedation. Motion carried unanimously.

DEEP SEDATION/GENERAL ANESTHESIA COMMITTEE

Mrs. Rimiller informed the Board that she would like to have a meeting with the Chairmen of the Deep Sedation/General Anesthesia Committee in order to clarify the on-site evaluation process. The Board agreed it would be a good idea to do so, and Dr. Sheets suggested that Mrs. Rimiller schedule the meeting to be held in conjunction with the July Board meeting.

UPDATE ON THE UMKC ENTERAL CONSCIOUS SEDATION COURSE

Mrs. Rimiller updated the Board regarding UMKC’s enteral conscious sedation course. She indicated that since the Board’s approval of the course it has been reported that the course would also qualify as meeting the fifteen hours of continuing education pertaining to medical emergencies. A motion was made by Dr. Sheets and seconded by Ms. Thompson that in addition to the UMKC enteral conscious sedation course being approved for meeting the initial requirements for a permit, that it also be approved for meeting the continuing education requirement for fifteen hours of continuing education pertaining to medical emergencies, anesthesia complications or patient management while under sedation. Motion carried unanimously.

ADJOURNMENT

There being no further business to be brought before the Board at this time, a motion was made by Dr. Sheets and seconded by Dr. McCoy that this meeting adjourn. Motion carried unanimously. The meeting adjourned at approximately 8:33 p.m.
