**ORDER**

On March 1, 2011, the above matter came on for hearing on respondent's motion to lift stay, filed February 4, 2011. Petitioners appeared by Salvatore Mirabile.

Respondent appeared by Sharon Euler. The Court heard oral argument on respondent's motion. Being duly advised in the premises, and for the reasons set forth on the record at the hearing on the motion, the Court determines that the public interest would be harmed by continuing the stay entered on January 14, 2011. Section 536.100, RSMo.

Accordingly, the Court enters the following Order:

1. The Court determines that respondent's motion should be, and the same is hereby, **GRANTED**. The Court's January 14, 2011 Order granting petitioners' motion for stay is hereby **VACATED AND SET ASIDE**. Respondent's Order of December 21, 2010 revoking petitioners' licenses shall be effective at 5:00 p.m. on March 11, 2011. Petitioners shall comply with all other provisions of that December 21, 2010 Order in accordance with the Order's terms.

2. The Court determines that the fees and expenses charged by the interim manager appointed pursuant to the Court's January 14, 2011 are reasonable and are

hereby approved. To the extent any amounts remain in the interim manager's trust account after deducting any fees and expenses accrued to date, those funds shall be returned to petitioners at the interim manager's earliest opportunity. The interim manager is hereby discharged.
