

Preneed Agent

In order to be a registered as a preneed agent with the State Board of Embalmers and Funeral Directors, an individual will first need to file the Notice of Intent form with the Board. When applications are available, an individual will need to complete and return to the Board (applications not available yet) . Upon review and approval of application by the Board, an individual will receive a certificate of eligibility from the Board in order to sit for the Missouri Law Exam through the International Conference of Funeral Service Examining Boards administered at Pearson Vue locations. Our website will be kept updated on this process as emergency rules are filed and approved with the Secretary of State.
