**Open Meeting Minutes
March 5, 2015**

Prerogatives of the Chair

Dr. DiRenna did not have prerogatives of the Chair.

Approval of Minutes

A motion was made by Dr. Lyskowski and seconded by Dr. Carter to approve the October 7, 2014 open meeting minutes. Dr. Carter, Dr. Freeman, and Dr. Lyskowski voted in favor of the motion. Motion carried unanimously.

Discussion of Proposed Re-entry Process

The committee reviewed and discussed a memorandum prepared by Sarah Schappe containing the definition of who qualifies for a reentry license and set specialized plan for each applicant from the state of Missouri. The committee also discussed topics that may need further discussion.

This item was for informational purposes and no action was taken by the Committee.

Discussion of Proposed Re-entry Statute

The committee reviewed and discussed proposed Re-entry statute and rule prepared by Sarah Schappe outlining qualifications and requirements.

The committee determined that section 1 of the proposed statute should be amended to state that not practicing as an MD or DO in the last two years means that one should be a “reentry applicant”.

The committee discussed whether a section should be added prohibiting holders or reentry licenses from supervising nurse practitioners, physician assistants, or other physician extenders. The committee did not reach a conclusion on this item and instructed that it should be discussed with the Board.

The committee instructed that section 1C of the proposed rule be amended to state “Completion of a ACGME or AOA approved post-graduate training program.”

Motion was made by Dr. Lyskowski and seconded by Dr. Freeman to place the modified statute, rule and accompanying information on the Board agenda for the May 2015 meeting.

Adjournment

Motion was made by Dr. Lyskowski and seconded by Dr. Carter to adjourn the meeting. The meeting adjourned approximately at 2:40 p.m. Motion carried unanimously.
