OCTOBER, 1984 NCLEX-PN EXAMINATION SITES

The October, 1984 NCLEX-PN examination will be given in St. Louis at Pipefitters Local 562, 12385 Larimore, St. Louis, Missouri, and at the Radisson Muehlebach, Baltimore at 12th, Kansas City, MO, on October 24, 1984.

IMPORTANT NOTICE

NCLEX applications for the October exam must be received by NCLEX before the August 29, 1984 deadline. Applications must be mailed by certified mail, accompanied by an \$18.50 money order made payable to NCSBN. Board applications for the October exam must be received at the Board office by September 7, 1984. A \$10.00 fee must accompany the application.

CTB/McGraw-Hill, the NCLEX testing Service reports that it has been receiving orders and payment for NCSBN publications at its test service location, often included in application materials for the examination from schools.

National Council of State Board of Nursing publications are not available from CTB/McGraw-Hill.

The Missouri State Board of Nursing announces the appointment of Florence McGuire as Executive Director

Effective August 6, 1984

Ms. McGuire brings a varied background to the Board. She received a diploma in nursing from Research Hospital; B.S.Ed., M.Ed., and Sp.Ed., University of Missouri-Columbia; and an M.S.N. with clinical speciality in Psychiatric Nursing, with emphasis in education and administration, University of Oklahoma. Her past work experience includes clinical nursing as well as education administration. Ms. McGuire presently is Chairperson, Applied Arts Division and Associate Degree Nursing Department, Eastern Oklahoma State College, Wilburton, Oklahoma. She will relocate to the central Missouri area in the near future.

INACTIVE, LAPSED, LICENSED IN ANOTHER STATE:

Missouri has mandatory licensure.

It is illegal to practice nursing in Missouri without a current Missouri license. A large number of persons who are posing as nurses are applying for employment in Missouri or are working in Missouri with lapsed licenses or inactive licenses. The Board office is asking for the assistance of those in administrative positions in facilities which employ nurses. This can be done by:

1. Hiring only people who can display a current license or temporary permit at the initial interview.
2. Developing a procedure for assuring currency of licensure and timely renewal for all licensed personnel.
3. Spreading by the word of mouth to reach those outside the arena of major employers of nurses.
4. When applicable, verifying that new graduates have passed the licensure examination and a license will be issued.

ALL NURSES MUST BE LICENSED IN MISSOURI, HAVE A CURRENT TEMPORARY PERMIT, OR FALL WITHIN THE EXEMPTION CLAUSE IN THE NURSING PRACTICE ACT WHICH STATES THAT NEW GRADUATES MAY PRACTICE UNDER PROPER SUPERVISION PENDING THE RESULTS OF THE FIRST LICENSING EXAMINATION SCHEDULED BY THE BOARD FOLLOWING GRADUATION.

LPN/IV THERAPY COURSE POLICY

"The maximum amount of theoretical instruction for the LPN/IV Therapy Course is not to exceed 8 (eight) hours per week." This policy was established by the Board at its regularly scheduled meeting on June 15, 1984.

IMPOSITION OF THE ORDER STAYED AND LICENSEE SUSPENDED FOR 3 YEARS. Licensee failed to record pertinent information, failed to monitor the fluid level of intravenous fluids, administered medications against directions and confused the terms "diastolic" and "systolic".
2. MARGY NELL WILLIAMS JACKSON, L.P.N., #13950, CURRENT 84-85, ST. LOUIS, MO. REVOKED
Licensee was placed on probation in 1981 for a period of 3 years with certain terms and conditions. The order of revocation was imposed for failure to meet the terms and conditions of probation.

Licensee diverted medical syringes, prescription blanks, and demerol from hospital supplies, and was intoxicated on duty. License revoked in Kansas.

Licensee misappropriated drugs and held herself out as an L.V.N., in Texas, when she was not licensed as a vocational nurse in Texas.

Licensee was placed on probation with certain terms and conditions in April, 1983. The order of revocation was imposed for failure to comply with those terms and conditions.
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Regular Board meetings are held at the Division of Professional Registration, 3523 North Ten Mile Drive, Jefferson City, Missouri, beginning at 8:30 each day unless otherwise designated. Meetings are open to the public except for discussion of licensure disciplinary problems. A Public Agenda is published for each meeting.

If you drive from the eastern part of the state via I-70, exit at Kingdom City, Highway 54 West, State Capitol Exit; proceed to Jefferson City via Highway 54 West. Cross the Bridge and take the Highway 50 West (Sedalia) Exit. Proceed on Highway 50 West to the second stop light, turn right onto North Ten Mile Drive. The office is located in a metal, cream-colored building, approximately .8 of a mile north of the Capital Mall.

If you drive from the western part of the state via I-70, exit at the Highway 63 South, Jefferson City exit in Columbia and proceed into Jefferson City via Highway 63 South. After crossing the bridge, proceed as above.

If you drive from the western part of the state via Highway 50 East, turn left onto North Ten Mile Drive at the first stoplight after passing the city limits sign, and follow this street until you reach our building as described above.

If you drive from the eastern part of the state via Highway 50 West, go all the way through Jefferson City until you reach the Capital Mall, turn right onto North Ten Mile Drive and proceed .8 of a mile North to our building as described above.

If you drive from the southern part of the state via Highway 54. Take the Highway 50 West (Sedalia) Exit. Proceed on Highway 50 West as described above.
