AAS: The student will be evaluated on his/her ability to fulfill the three nursing roles of provider of care, manager of care, and member within the discipline of nursing. Clinical laboratory performance is evaluated on a Pass/Fail basis. A student must pass all areas of performance to satisfactorily complete the course.

- Pass (P) is received for performance indicating student has met clinical objectives.
- Fail (F) is received for performance indicating student has not met clinical objectives, or where student performance has not improved after receiving feedback from instructor.

A. ASSESSMENT:	MIDTERM P/F	FINAL P/F
1. Practices physical assessment skills in clinical laboratory, seeking assistance as needed.		
2. Practices measurement of vital signs in clinical laboratory, seeking assistance as needed.		
3. Utilizes skills of observation, interview, and assessment to collect data on client.		
4. Accurately assesses client's vital signs.		
5. Documents assessment and vital signs accurately and completely.		
6. Using the Daily Assessment Guide, assesses unmet needs of oxygenation, rest, mobility, nutrition, elimination, fluid balance, comfort, skin integrity, chemical and thermal safety, chemical safety, love and belonging, self-esteem, and self-actualization in assigned clients.		
7. Assesses unmet needs of the surgical client.		
8. Differentiates between normal and abnormal assessment data.		
9. Documents data based on client's unmet needs.		
10. Assesses the verbal and nonverbal communications of clients when completing the process recording.		
11. Assesses the learning needs of assigned client.

1. Selects appropriate nursing diagnoses from standardized list with identified related to statements.		
2. Writes realistic measurable goals based on assessment data collected.		
3. Plans care using standardized nursing care plans to meet stated client goals.		
4. Plans strategies for completing nursing care in a timely manner.		
5. Plans for medication administration by looking up medication actions and side effects.		
6. Listens to report from staff nurse, clarifying assignments as needed.		
7. Participates in pre conference strategies for delivering care.		
8. Supports clients' rights to make decisions regarding care.		
9. Designs a teaching plan to teach about a client about selected medications.

7. Demonstrates beginning charting competency by successful completion of computer-based charting modules.		
8. Demonstrates 90-100% accuracy in the performance of drug calculation skills in the math practicum.		
9. Demonstrates 75-100% accuracy in the performance of nursing skills in the lab practicum.		
10. Completes Supplemental Instruction based on _____ (normed test) score by assigned deadline.
