

Practice Lab & Simulation Lab Rules and Policies

1. No eating or drinking inside the laboratories.
2. Students must wear nursing uniforms while in the lab.
3. Students must return kits and items back into the supply cabinet and discard used items in the appropriate receptacle. Must leave the lab in a clean and orderly manner.
4. Students **may not** practice any invasive procedures.
5. Students may not take any items from the lab for one's own personal use.
6. Students will maintain professional attitude and demeanor.
7. Students may not use ink pens or Betadine around the manikins.
8. All medications within the laboratory setting are simulated, and should not be consumed by anyone.
9. All manikins and task trainers must be handled carefully and respectfully.
10. Students need to comply with the confidentiality pledge during simulation activities.
11. Students are expected to come prepared for all simulation exercises and will be provided with objectives, description, and topics for preparation for the simulation scenario.
12. Students who are not prepared, disruptive, or disrespectful to fellow students &/ faculty will be asked to leave the simulation.
13. Students will utilize electronic devices as they relate to simulation experience only.
