

DEAR PROSPECTIVE LICENSEE:

Enclosed is an Application for Preliminary Evaluation of Foreign Pharmacy School Graduate that you requested. You may not apply for any license until this application has been submitted to our office and approved.

One of the documents that you are required to obtain before applying to our office is the Foreign Pharmacy Graduate Equivalency Certification (FPGEC), which is provided by the National Association of Boards of Pharmacy (NABP). If you do not have the FPGEC Certificate, contact their office for more information:

You are required to show proof of practical experience which is equal to the requirements set forth in 20 CSR 2220-2.030 (2), (3) and (6), (c).

**PLEASE NOTE:** If your intern hours were completed in the United States and were earned before the date printed on your FPGEC certificate, the hours will not be acceptable by the Missouri board of pharmacy.

In this instance, your foreign pharmacy application would be approved without the hours and you would then be required to apply for an intern license (in Missouri) to accumulate the number of hours needed (1,500) to take the pharmacist exam.
