JOINT STIPULATION AND AGREEMENT BETWEEN
THE STATE COMMITTEE OF PSYCHOLOGISTS
AND DAVID SALVA, PH.D., REGARDING
VOLUNTARY SURRENDER OF LICENSE OF
DAVID SALVA

I.

Come now David Salva, Ph.D. ("Licensee") and the State Committee of Psychologists ("Committee") and enter into this Joint Stipulation and Agreement ("Agreement") regarding Licensee's voluntary surrender of his license to practice psychology.

Licensee understands and agrees that by executing this Agreement, Licensee is voluntarily surrendering his right to practice psychology in the State of Missouri. For its part, the Committee understands and agrees that by executing this Agreement, the Committee relinquishes jurisdiction over Licensee's license in all matters pertaining to such license.

II.

Licensee and the Committee hereby jointly stipulate to the following facts:

1. The Committee is an agency of the State of Missouri created and established pursuant to Section 370.050, RSMo for the purpose of executing and enforcing the provisions of Chapter 337, RSMo.
2. The Licensee is licensed by the Committee as a psychologist, License No. PY0078. The Licensee's Missouri license is current and active.
3. In September, 1992, the Licensee retired from his position with the Veteran's Administration, where he served as a psychologist for 25 years.

4. In addition to his work with the VA, Licensee counseled patients as part of an independent private practice.
5. In addition to the VA and private practice, Licensee has participated from time to time in outside business opportunities unrelated to the practice of psychology.
6. While the rules governing the practice of psychology do not prohibit a psychologist from pursuing business interests outside of psychology, the rules place limitations on dual relationships between psychologist and patient.
7. The rules governing dual relationships can be implicated even where an intent to circumvent the spirit and letter of the rules does not exist. For example, four patients of Licensee participated financially in a limited partnership in which Licensee was a partner.
8. At this time, Licensee desires to discontinue the practice of psychology and surrender his license in order that he may pursue outside business opportunities unrelated to the practice of psychology. Licensee does not believe that the practice of psychology is compatible with the pursuit of outside business interests and he prefers to concentrate his efforts exclusively on business activities at this time.

III.

In light of the foregoing stipulation of facts, Licensee and the Committee consent and agree as follows:

1. Licensee shall submit all copies and originals of Licensee's psychologist license, wallhanging and wallet certificate to the Committee within ten (10) days of the effective date of this Agreement.

2. Upon the voluntary surrender of license, the Committee shall relinquish jurisdiction over Licensee's license in all matters pertaining to such license.

3. The parties to this Agreement understand that the Committee will maintain this Agreement as an open record of the Committee as provided in Chapter 337, 610 and 620 RSMo.
