**What is Traditional?** Educational programs attended either in person or remotely by the use of telecommunication technology where the presentation is “live” and where the attendee can interact with and ask questions of the presenter during the presentation.

**What is Non-Traditional?** Programs that include a testing mechanism, not presented “live” where the attendee is not able to interact with and ask questions of the presenter during the presentation.
