ORDER OF THE MISSOURI
STATE COMMITTEE FOR SOCIAL WORKERS
DISCIPLINING THE CLINICAL SOCIAL WORKER LICENSE OF
ABDULLAH JAMAAL M. ALI

On or about October 17, 2013, the Administrative Hearing Commission entered its Decision in the case of *State Committee for Social Workers v. Abdullah Jamaal M. Ali*, Case No. 13-0264 SW. In that Decision, the Administrative Hearing Commission found that Respondent Abdullah Jamaal M. Ali’s clinical social worker license (license # 005400) is subject to disciplinary action by the State Committee for Social Workers (“Committee”) pursuant to § 337.630.2(4), (5), (6), (13) and (15), RSMo.¹

The Committee has received and reviewed the record of the proceedings before the Administrative Hearing Commission and the Decision of the Administrative Hearing Commission. The record and Decision of the Administrative Hearing Commission is incorporated herein by reference in its entirety.

Pursuant to notice and §§ 621.110 and 337.630.4, RSMo, the Committee held a hearing on December 12, 2013, at approximately 11:00 a.m., at the Division of Professional Registration, 3605 Missouri Boulevard, Jefferson City, Missouri, for the purpose of determining the appropriate disciplinary action against Respondent's license. The Committee was represented by Assistant Attorney General Michael Cherba. Respondent, having received proper notice and opportunity to appear, did not appear personally or through legal counsel. After being present and considering all of the evidence presented during the hearing, the Committee issues the following Findings of Facts, Conclusions of Law and Order.

Based upon the foregoing the Committee states:

I.

FINDINGS OF FACT

1. The Committee is an agency of the state of Missouri created and established pursuant to § 337.622, RSMo, for the purpose of licensing persons engaged in the practice of social work in this state. The Board has control and supervision of the licensed occupations and enforcement of the terms and provisions of §§ 337.600 to 337.689, RSMo.

2. The Committee hereby adopts and incorporates by reference the Decision of the Administrative Hearing Commission in *State Committee for Social Workers v. Abdullah Jamaal M. Ali*, Case No. 13-0264 SW, issued on October 17, 2013, in its entirety, including the motion for summary determination filed by the Committee and all evidence admitted in support thereof.

3. The Committee set this matter for disciplinary hearing and served notice of the disciplinary hearing upon Respondent in a proper and timely fashion. Respondent did not appear personally or through legal counsel.

II.

CONCLUSIONS OF LAW

4. This Committee has jurisdiction over this proceeding pursuant to § 621.110 and § 337.630.4, RSMo.

5. The Committee expressly adopts and incorporates by reference the Conclusions of Law contained in the Decision issued by the Administrative Hearing Commission on October 17, 2013, in *State Committee for Social Workers v. Abdullah Jamaal M. Ali*, Case No. 13-0264 SW, and hereby enters its Conclusions of Law consistent therewith.

6. As a result of the foregoing, and in accordance with the Administrative Hearing Commission's Decision of October 17, 2013, Respondent's clinical social worker license, number 005400, is subject to disciplinary action by the Committee pursuant to § 337.630.2(4), (5), (6), (13) and (15), RSMo.

7. The Committee has determined that this Order is necessary to ensure the protection of the public.

III.

ORDER

Having fully considered all the evidence before the Committee, and giving full weight to the Decision of the Administrative Hearing Commission, it is the ORDER of the Committee that the clinical social worker license of Abdullah Jamaal M. Ali, license number 005400) is hereby **REVOKED**. It is further ordered that Mr. Ali shall immediately return all evidence of licensure to the Committee.

The Board will maintain this Order as an open, public record of the Committee as provided in chapters 337, 610 and 324, RSMo.
