ORDER FOR TEMPORARY RELIEF FROM AGENCY DECISION

COMES NOW the Court, and considers Petitioner's request for an order, pursuant to Section 536.120 RSMo, directing the Missouri Real Estate Appraisers Commission ("Commission") to allow him to continue in his practice as a certified residential real estate appraiser. Having considered Petitioner's verified motion, the Court finds that Petitioner has alleged threatened irreparable harm that will occur if he is denied the opportunity to continue practicing during the pendency of his case. Notably, Petitioner has been a practicing certified residential real estate appraiser for approximately 10 years and a wife and two children to support.


Therefore, it is the ORDER of this Court effective immediately, that the Missouri Real Estate Appraisers Commission's order revoking Petitioner's state certification as a residential real estate appraiser be stayed during the pendency of this appeal.
