ORDER FOR PERMANENT INJUNCTION

This cause comes before the Court for hearing on July 30, 2010 on Petitioner's Motion for Permanent Injunction. Respondent fails to appear for the hearing. Upon the Court having examined the motion and being fully advised in the premises;

Accordingly, it is hereby:

ORDERED that Respondent, Keith Shaw, has violated § 329.030, RSMo, by offering to engage and engaging in the occupation of cosmetology for compensation in Missouri without a current and valid license issued by the Board. Respondent is hereby permanently restrained and enjoined from engaging in any acts or practices for which a license to practice cosmetology is required under Chapter 329, RSMo., unless and until he receives a cosmetology license issued by the Board.


ORDERED that Respondent, Keith Shaw, has violated § 329.045., RSMo, by operating an establishment in which the occupation of cosmetology is practiced without at license. Respondent is hereby permanently restrained and enjoined from engaging in any acts or practices for which an establishment license is required under Chapter 329, RSMo, unless and until he receives an

establishment license issued by the Board

ORDERED that should Respondent, Keith Shaw continue to engage in business without having both a cosmetology license and establishment license, he will be subject to criminal charges pursuant to § 329.250, RSMo, which makes violation of Chapter 329 a class C misdemeanor.

IT IS SO ORDERED.


