

ASBOG Examination Application Instructions**

1. Complete the ASBOG® Examination application in its entirety and return to our office with the \$25.00 Administration fee. (The examination fee will be paid to the testing center later.)
2. Payment may be made in the form of a personal check, cashier's check or money order made payable to the State Board of Geologist Registration. **ALL FEES ARE NON-REFUNDABLE.**
3. Please request official final transcript(s) to be forwarded directly to our office if you have not already done so.
4. Attach a recent passport photograph of yourself in the designated area on the application. The photographs must be approximately 2" x 2" in size and show a clear picture of your face.

**** Senior Status Graduates Applying To Take the ASBOG® Fundamentals of Geology (FG) Examination as an Exit Examination**

The Board of Geologist Registration's rule, 20 CSR 2145-2.040 was revised and became effective January 31, 2020. This rule allows senior status graduates to take the ASBOG® Fundamentals of Geology (FG) examination as an exit examination only once and provides further criteria the applicant must meet:

1. Must be an undergraduate in senior status.
2. The FG examination may be a requirement for graduation. *(NOTE: If the student fails the examination and wishes to reapply, the applicant would need to then meet graduate requirements i.e. will have to request college or university to provide an official FINAL transcript upon graduation of the program.)*
3. A signed letter from the department head/chair indicating applicant has been approved to sit for the FG examination as an exit examination.

General Information

- You will receive a letter following the Board of Geologist Registration's review of your application and supporting documentation indicating whether or not you were found eligible to take the examination. You will also receive information on when and how to enroll for your preferred testing center and time (either 8:00 am or 1:00 pm).
- The Computer-Based-Testing will be administered at multiple testing centers around the state as arranged by ASBOG. Once your application is approved by the Board, your information will be entered into a testing database. This will trigger an e-mail from registrations@isoqualitytesting.com. This e-mail will provide you with instructions on how to register, pay, and select a Prometric testing location and time as well as your Username and Password needed to do this. Seating at each testing center is limited to their available seating, so we recommend enrolling as soon as you receive the e-mail. Candidates are allowed four (4) hours to complete each portion of the exam.

Please note that all documentation (application, fee, transcripts and/or letter from department head/chair as applicable) must be received by the MO Exam Registration Deadline listed in the table below.
