At 8:00 a.m., the Missouri State Committee of Marital and Family Therapists conference call meeting was called to order by Ted Estes, Chairperson at the Division of Professional Registration located at 3605 Missouri Boulevard in Jefferson City. The executive director facilitated roll call.

Mr. Estes stated he would be voting in open and closed session.

A motion was made by Ms. Michael and seconded by Ms. Modrell to approve the open session agenda. State committee members voting aye: Mr. Estes, Dr. Smith, Ms. Michael, and Ms. Modrell. Motion carried unanimously.

A motion was made by Ms. Michael and seconded by Ms. Modrell to approve the September 20th open session minutes amending the address on the minutes and the October 16th open session minutes amending the mailing of continuing education changes to licensees. State committee members voting aye: Mr. Estes, Dr. Smith, Ms. Michael, and Ms. Modrell. Motion carried unanimously.

Licensure Supervision

The state committee reviewed requirements for supervisors in other states as well as mental health licensure committees within the division. The state committee requested the executive director identify licensees that frequently supervisor individuals for licensure and how many supervisees each supervisor has at any one time.

New Mexico

The state committee reviewed the supervisor requirements for New Mexico and determined that New Mexico does not require education in supervision, clinical experience in marital and family therapy, and supervisory experience in marital and family therapy. Therefore, the supervisor requirements were not substantially the same as Missouri

Wisconsin

The state committee reviewed the licensure requirements for Wisconsin and determined the areas of education and examination were substantially the same as Missouri. Licensure supervisors do not have to complete supervision of supervision and or obtain education in supervision. Finally, Wisconsin requires 1,000 hours direct client contact. In the area of supervision, Wisconsin requirements are not substantially the same as Missouri.
