The board members reviewed and made one revision to the proposed rules by adding the word income to 20 CSR 2234-2.010 (H) (1). The proposed rules that were reviewed are attached.

Ms. Goose asked the Board if a person has acquired continuing education prior to licensure if that continuing education will count. After discussion, the Board decided that any continuing education acquired prior to becoming licensed will not be accepted.

Ms. Goose said now that all the draft rules have been accepted she will post them on the website so the Board can get some feedback on them. Ms. Goose informed the Board that she has a postcard that will be mailed to everyone on mailing list instructing them to go to website to view the draft rules. Ms. Goose passed out a handout titled Frequently Asked Questions for the Board's review and revision if needed. Ms. Goose indicated that the FAQ handout will also be placed on the website for informational purposes. The Board had detailed discussion regarding the FAQ handout, and asked that revisions be made to it before it is posted on the website.

Ms. Goose asked the Board if she can go ahead and get the draft rules posted to the website once she makes the one revision, and the Board said yes.

Report related to exam and reciprocity requirements in other states:

Ms. Goose provided a list of other state licensing requirements in regard to felony convictions for the board's review. The Board was also provided copies of reciprocal agreements from other states for their review.

Ms. Goose stated that she will try to get proposed fee information together prior to the November 24, 2008 meeting for review and discussion.

The Board had detailed discussion regarding minimum competency testing and comprehensive testing. Mr. Barrett informed the Board that Tennessee is using Prometric with is a national online testing service.

Legal Counsel Report:

Mr. Barrett stated that Kansas City, last month posed that their legal consul's view was that this statute supersedes their licensing; even though, technically it is not local. Mr. Barrett said that the Saint Louis Police Commissioner's general consul made the same decision. Mr. Barrett stated that we no longer have the issue about whether we truly are statewide.
