ORDER OF THE MISSOURI  
STATE COMMITTEE FOR SOCIAL WORKERS  
DISCIPLINING THE CLINICAL SOCIAL WORKER LICENSE OF  
BARBARA ANN BAILEY

On or about September 7, 2011, the Administrative Hearing Commission entered its Decision in the case of *Missouri State Committee for Social Workers v. Barbara Ann Bailey*, Case No. 10-0619 SW. In that Decision, the Administrative Hearing Commission found that Respondent Barbara Ann Bailey’s clinical social worker license (license # 002381) is subject to disciplinary action by the State Committee for Social Workers (“Committee”) pursuant to § 337.630.2(4), (5), (6), (13) and (15), RSMo.<sup>1</sup>

The Committee has received and reviewed the record of the proceedings before the Administrative Hearing Commission and the Decision of the Administrative Hearing Commission. The record and Decision of the Administrative Hearing Commission is incorporated herein by reference in its entirety.

Pursuant to notice and §§ 621.110 and 337.630.4, RSMo, the Committee held a hearing on June 7, 2012, at approximately 1:05 p.m., at Candlewood Suites, 3514 Amazonas Drive, Jefferson City, Missouri 65102 for the purpose of determining the appropriate disciplinary action against Respondent's license. The Committee was represented by Assistant Attorney General Michael Cherba. Respondent, having received proper notice and opportunity to appear, did not appear in person or through legal counsel. After being present and considering all of the evidence presented during the hearing, the Committee issues the following Findings of Facts, Conclusions of Law and Order.

Based upon the foregoing the Committee states:

I.

FINDINGS OF FACT

1. The Committee is an agency of the state of Missouri created and established pursuant to § 337.622, RSMo, for the purpose of licensing persons engaged in the practice of social work in this state. The Board has control and supervision of the licensed occupations and enforcement of the terms and provisions of sections 337.600 to 337.689, RSMo.

2. The Committee hereby adopts and incorporates by reference the Decision of the Administrative Hearing Commission in *Missouri State Committee for Social Workers v. Barbara Ann Bailey*, Case No. 10-0619 SW, issued on September 7, 2011, in its entirety.

3. The Committee set this matter for disciplinary hearing and served notice of the disciplinary hearing upon Respondent in a proper and timely fashion. Respondent failed to appear in person or through legal counsel at the hearing before the Committee.

II.

CONCLUSIONS OF LAW

4. This Committee has jurisdiction over this proceeding pursuant to § 621.110 and § 337.630.4, RSMo.

5. The Committee expressly adopts and incorporates by reference the Conclusions of Law contained in the Decision issued by the Administrative Hearing Commission on September 7, 2011, in *Missouri State Committee for Social Workers v. Barbara Ann Bailey*, Case No. 10-0619 SW, and hereby enters its Conclusions of Law consistent therewith.

6. As a result of the foregoing, and in accordance with the Administrative Hearing Commission's Decision of September 7, 2011, Respondent's clinical social worker license, number 002381, is subject to disciplinary action by the Committee pursuant to § 337.630.2(4), (5), (6), (13) and (15), RSMo.

7. The Committee has determined that this Order is necessary to ensure the protection of the public.

III.

ORDER

Having fully considered all the evidence before the Committee, and giving full weight to the Decision of the Administrative Hearing Commission, it is the ORDER of the Committee that the clinical social worker license of Barbara Ann Bailey (license no. 002381) is hereby REVOKED. It is further ordered that Ms. Bailey shall immediately return all evidence of licensure to the Committee.

The Board will maintain this Order as an open, public record of the Committee as provided in chapters 337, 610, and 324, RSMo.
