**FINDINGS OF FACT, CONCLUSIONS OF LAW  
AND DISCIPLINARY ORDER**

On July 9, 2024, the Administrative Hearing Commission entered its “Default Decision” in the case of *Missouri State Committee for Social Workers v. Darla Maynard*, Case number 24 - 0115. In the Decision, the Administrative Hearing Commission found that Petitioner is entitled to the relief requested in the complaint filed, in accordance with Section 621.100.2, RSMo. As such, Respondent’s license to practice clinical social work is subject to discipline pursuant to Section 337.630.2 (5), (6), and (11), RSMo<sup>1</sup> and 20 CSR 2263-2.082(1), (11), and (12), 20 CSR 2263-3.020(5) and 20 CSR 2263-3.010.

The State Committee for Social Workers (the “Committee”) received and reviewed the record of proceedings of the Administrative Hearing Commission. The record of the Administrative Hearing Commission, including the February 7, 2024, properly filed Complaint, is incorporated herein by reference in its entirety as if set forth in this Order.

The Committee set this matter for hearing and properly served upon Respondent notice of the time, date and location of the hearing.

Pursuant to notice and Section 621.110, RSMo, the Committee held a disciplinary hearing on September 20, 2024, at the Division of Professional Registration, 3605 Missouri Boulevard, Jefferson City, Missouri 65102, for the purpose of determining the appropriate disciplinary action, if any, to be taken against the master social worker license held by Respondent. The Committee began the hearing at 2:45 a.m. Assistant Attorney General Mary Moulton appeared on behalf of the Committee. Respondent did not appear at the scheduled hearing, nor was she represented at the hearing by legal counsel.

After full review of the record and the evidence and testimony presented at hearing, the Committee issues this Findings of Fact, Conclusions of Law and Disciplinary Order:

1. The Committee is an agency of the State of Missouri, created and existing pursuant to Section 337.622, RSMo, for the purpose of carrying out the provisions of Sections 333.600 through 337.689, RSMo.
2. Respondent Maynard holds master social worker license number 2013014222, that was current and active at all times relevant to this matter.
3. The Committee adopts and incorporates by reference the properly pled Complaint, the Decision and the record of the Administrative Hearing Commission in the case of *Missouri State Committee for Social Workers v. Darla Maynard*, Case number 24-0115. The Committee takes official notice of its file in this matter.
4. The Committee properly set this matter for disciplinary hearing and properly served notice of the disciplinary hearing on Respondent.

5. Respondent failed to provide the Petitioner with proof of her continuing education for the reporting period of October 1, 2020, through September 30, 2022, as requested by the Committee pursuant to several random audit requests. By failing to respond to the Committee's random audit letters, the Respondent violated section 337.630.2 (5), (6), and (11), RSMo, 20 CSR 2263-2.082(1), (11), and (12), 20 CSR 2263-3.020(5) and 20 CSR 2263-3.010, as identified and incorporated by reference from the properly pled Complaint of February 7, 2024.

6. The Committee has jurisdiction over this proceeding pursuant to Section 621.110, RSMo, and Section 337.630.4, RSMo.


7. The Committee finds that this Order is necessary to protect the public.

8. **THEREFORE**, having fully considered the evidence before the Committee and giving full weight to the Findings of Fact and Conclusions of Law as found by the Administrative Hearing Commission, the State Committee of Social Workers orders that the master social worker license, number 2013014222, held by Respondent Darla Maynard, be **REVOKED**. Respondent shall immediately return all indicia of licensure to the Committee.

The Committee will maintain this Order as an open and public record of the Committee as provided in Chapters 324, 337, 610, and 620, RSMo.
